Dear EBYO Friends and Families,

A season which we hope will be unique in the annals of EBYO - and the world - is coming to an end. Our students have really risen to the occasion, with Zoom rehearsals and submissions of tracks for virtual performances. It takes a lot to stick with such a changed environment, which has provided so much less interpersonal contact and feedback from being surrounded by the sound of other instruments in rehearsals. Our students acclimated themselves very well, took their changed circumstances in stride, and produced outstanding virtual performances which can be viewed via our website, ebyo.org.

We have been checking the availability of summer opportunities for our students. Our information is that La Honda Music Camp will be meeting virtually and students can sign up for one week or two weeks. The Odd Fellows Summer Chamber Music Camp will not be held this summer. The Sequoia Chamber Music Workshop, led by our own Dr. Bill, will also not be meeting. Instead of their usual summer music camp, the Jenny Lin Foundation will offer a program of high school students mentoring middle school students, for Castro Valley residents only.

Like the rest of the world, we are deeply hopeful that we can go back to the inperson format in September and are planning for that. I think it will be a sort of revelation to feel so strongly the ties of the group experience, and I think we will all be incredibly thankful and appreciative in a way we never were before. Our auditions will still be virtual until the audition video due date of June 1, and we'll see where we are after that. With the help of donors and city and county grants, our fiscal health is strong. We look forward with great hope to the future!

PEARLS FROM THE PODIUM FROM DR. BILL HARRINGTON

Thirteen months ago, EBYO played its last live concert on Sunday March 1, 2020. The Symphony's program included the Finale from Schubert's Symphony No. 9, "The Great," Kabalevsky's Piano Concerto #3, with Student Concerto Winner, Valentin Shatilenko, and the "Berceuse and Finale" from Stravinsky's *Firebird Suite*. On March 10, we had our last live rehearsal thinking we would soon return in a couple of weeks after the danger of COVID passed. Little did we realize it would take so long! As the quarantine dragged on in the Spring of 2020, EBYO was forced to cancel the rest of its season and made refunds for the remainder of the year to families who requested them.

Slowly, music educators became aware of new technologies available that could enable some resemblance of music participation. These included ZOOM rehearsals and virtual concerts where students record themselves while playing with a pre-recorded track. A video engineer aligns and stitches the videos together to produce what we now call a virtual concert. In the fall of 2020, with the help of technology, EBYO started online rehearsals with a core of loyal members and families. Under the guidance of the staff conductors and coaches, students practiced and learned music by following selected *YouTube* recordings.

EBYO produced four virtual concert videos over the next six months. These virtual concerts included Selections from *The Sound of Music*, Borodin's *Polovtzian Dances*, *Beauty and the Beast* Medley, and a Showcase Concert video that featured students playing instrumental solos as well as Horizons Ensembles performing chamber music virtually. The *Polovtzian Dances* video, rehearsed under the guidance of our CSUEB Associate Conductor, Omar Ortiz, was an outstanding success and very well received in the community. The video was played for the Hayward City Council in support of the City Council's Resolution to name March as *Arts Is Education Month*. Our remaining virtual concert projects include a Medley from *Phantom of the Opera* and two violin concertos by Bruch and Mozart, featuring two Student Concerto Winners, Aaron Hsi and Meghna Thumri.

Our students' response to EBYO programs was exceptional. Twenty-three of our 40 Symphony members volunteered to join one of our four Horizons Ensembles. These student-led chamber groups meet every Tuesday night 6:30-7:15 before the regular full rehearsal. Each group prepares chamber music repertoire to present to the community through virtual concerts or live at community service events if allowed by the county health officials in the near future.

There is light at the end of the tunnel! Through distribution of EBYO's virtual concert videos and widening recognition, many new families are enrolling their music students in EBYO orchestral programs. We are all looking forward to September 2021, when we can all hopefully come together again face to face!
