PEARLS FROM THE PODIUM FROM DR. BILL HARRINGTON

Dear EBYO members, friends and families,

I have been busy this summer recruiting for and advertising East Bay Youth Orchestras in the community and at summer music camps. We added new members from the Jenny Lin Summer Music program, the Sequoia Chamber Music Workshop, and the Hayward Odd Fellows Chamber Music camp. Many new members were accepted on important instruments that will help round out both of our orchestras into full symphony orchestras. Having a full orchestra will enable our EBYO Symphony to perform masterworks and favorites of the symphonic repertoire including Tchaikovsky's Symphony No. 2, Night on Bald Mountain, and Dvořák's Symphony No. 8 in our three Classical concerts this season. The Concert Orchestra will continue to perform standards from the school orchestra repertoire. Our Fall Concert will feature our Co-Concertmaster Aaron Hsi in his International Great Composers Competition award-winning "Best Wieniawski Performance". Our Winter and Spring Concerts will feature soloists from the Cal State East Bay Music Department faculty. We will continue to open our season with a free community Pops Concert in Hayward Memorial Grove on Sunday, September 25. Our theme this year will be celebrating music of the Latin Americas and a reprise of Carlos Montoya's Huapango from our Spring Concert.

We welcome Irene Cheng as our new Associate Conductor. Irene is pursuing her master's degree in music education at Cal State East Bay and is already an experienced music teacher and scholar as well as a fine percussionist who joined us last year. All of our rehearsals and concerts will be held in the Music Building or Theater at CSUEB. The Concert Orchestra will be meeting Tuesday nights 6:00-7:00 pm, and the Symphony Orchestra will be meeting 7:15-9:15 pm. We will again be forming new Horizons Ensembles (small student-directed chamber groups that will perform in the community as community service) which will rehearse 6:30-7:10 pm. Please let me know if you are interested in volunteering for one of these groups.

I am looking forward to meeting our new members as well as seeing our returning students on Tuesday, September 6!

Concert Dates:

As we start the new season, here are some important EBYO dates to mark on your calendars.

Concert dates: The dates for the 2022-2023 season are tentatively set for: Sept. 25, Nov. 13 and Dec. 11, 2022; March 5 and May 21, 2023.

The location for most of our concerts will be the CSUEB Recital Hall or the CSUEB Theater. We will hold a community Pops Concert on Sept. 25 at the Hayward Memorial Park near the Plunge, and a Sensory-Friendly Concert on Dec. 11, 2022 (location to be determined).

Rehearsal Attendance:

Rehearsals are Tuesday evenings, 6-7 pm for Concert Orchestra and 7:15-9:15 pm for Symphony Orchestra. We will be adding one special rehearsal on Thursday, Sept. 22, for Symphony Orchestra, to prepare for our Sept. 25 Pops Concert. Rehearsals are essential for students' musical growth and for the cohesion of each group. In their membership agreements, students have made a commitment to attend rehearsals unless they are ill or have a school performance scheduled for that time. We urge all parents and students to make EBYO rehearsals a priority each week so that they, and their group, can uphold the standards set by our conductor.

Tuition:



PARKING WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

BE SURE TO PURCHASE A PARKING PERMIT AT A PARKING KIOSK (located in Lot N off of Carlos Bee Blvd. just short of Loop Road), at the kiosk on the right at the top of Harder Rd. in Lot K.) Permits are \$2/hour; after 5:00 general parking is allowed in faculty/staff lots as well as general lots. The closet parking for the Music Building is in Lot L (Theater Lot). After Opening Night, you will not need a parking permit to just drop off students for rehearsal.

From Oakland, Highway 880 south: Follow 880 to the Jackson St. East turnoff in Hayward. As you come off the freeway go to the first signal and make a right turn there on Santa Clara. Santa Clara will turn into Harder Road. Follow Harder Road 1-1/2 miles to the University. Buy a parking permit at the kiosk on the right at the top of Harder. Turn left on West Loop Road to parking lots.

From Oakland Highway 580 south: Follow Highway 580 to Hayward exiting at the 238 / South Hayward turnoff. Stay left as you exit and go straight. (The two left lanes turn left onto Castro Valley Blvd,) This brings you onto Foothill Blvd. Follow Foothill, staying in the left lane. From the left lane you will be able to merge right on A Street because Foothill becomes one way the wrong way at that point. Then left turn on Mission Blvd, staying in the left lane. Follow Mission Blvd. to Carlos Bee Blvd. Left turn on Carlos Bee Blvd. Stay in the right lane. Cal State is at the top of the hill. Buy a parking permit in Lot N (last lot on the right before Loop Road).

From San Jose, Fremont, Union City and surrounding areas via Highway 880: From 880 North take the Jackson St. east turnoff in Hayward. As you come off the freeway go to the first signal and make a right turn on Santa Clara. Santa Clara will turn into Harder Road. Follow Harder Road 1-1/2 miles up the hill to the University. Buy a parking permit at the kiosk on the right at the top of Harder. Turn left on W. Loop Rd. to parking lots.

From the Walnut Creek and San Ramon areas via Highway 680 south: Take 680 south to 580 west. Take the Castro Valley turnoff. As you come off the freeway make 3 immediate left turns (following the Hayward signs). This will bring you heading down Center Street. At the bottom of the hill, at the next light bear right onto B Street. Follow B Street to Mission Blvd., turn left on Mission Blvd. Follow Mission Blvd. to Carlos Bee Blvd. Make a left turn there and stay in the right lane. Cal State is at the top of the hill. Buy a parking permit in Lot N (last lot on the right before Loop Rd.).

From the Pleasanton/Livermore area follow the above directions from 580 west on.

From Fremont via Mission Blvd. north: Turn right onto Harder Rd. Buy parking permit at the top on the right. Then turn left on W. Loop Rd. to parking lots.
